ABOUT THE SEASON

The 2023 growing season in Paso Robles' Willow Creek District was defined by a cooler-than-usual summer and plenty of winter rain, giving the vines the perfect balance of moisture and a slower ripening cycle. The extended hang time allowed for a more even and nuanced development of the grapes, leading to wines with fresh, vibrant acidity and deep, layered flavors. A later harvest brought complexity and balance, making the 2023 vintage from Willow Creek standout for its refined character and structure.

TASTING NOTE

Our 2023 Rosé is a classic Provence-style wine, made entirely from Grenache Noir grapes. Gently pressed in a basket press to extract minimal color and avoid harsh tannins, it results in a delicate, pale wine with a crisp, refreshing acidity. Tropical notes of fresh melon and citrus dance on the palate, adding a vibrant layer to the wine's elegant structure. The balance of freshness and fruit makes it perfect for enjoying on a warm day, with a clean, vibrant finish that lingers.
